This Glossary and Index was created for The Rabbi's Tarot, All words that are capitalized represent KEY information (symbol or Archetype) and as such often represent more than the general interpretation of the word.

### A

**Aaron** – Brother of Moses. - p44

**ABN** (Aben) - Hebrew for Stone. – p58

**ABOVE** – Direction assigned to the Double Letter Beth, the Planet Mercury and the Magician, which represents Superior Consciousness and is assigned Inductive Reasoning. –ps19,29,33,137,159,269, 286,339

**ABOVE TO BELOW** –Direction assigned to the Fool, Mother Letter Aleph, the Planet Uranus, and the Element Air.

**ABSOLUTE** - Both 0 and 9 typify the **Absolute**. Zero is the **Absolute** as it leaves the Source and enters into manifestation. Nine is the **Absolute** as the goal of existence. – ps3,159

**Abstract Thought** – Symbolized by the summit of the Mountain the Hermit stands upon which represents as much of the Spirit as we are able to recognize in our physical bodies. – ps26,89,105, 159,326

**ACCOMPLISHMENT** – One of the attributes the Wheel of Fortune represents. - p171

**ACTION OF MIND** – Term represented by the Color Yellow indicating the Mind receiving instruction from the Spirit. - p171

**Adam** – Allegory for the Self-Consciousness and in Theology the Natural man. – ps20,21,47,48,102, 135,149,259,344

**ADMINISTRATIVE INTELLIGENCE** – Intelligence assigned to card 21 the World representing the Saturn Center. The **Administrative Intelligence** orders all life's activities within their proper bounds and limits by feeding the etheric centers their appropriate amount of etheric fire from the Earth. - ps348

**ADNI** – Divine name with the value of 65. – p263

**ADONAI** – English version of ADNI and the Mars vibration as it is used by Divinity. - ps263,324,325

**ADVANCEMENT** – A definition the Wheel in the Wheel of Fortune symbolizes. – p171

**AGELESS WISDOM** - Term that defines the Subconscious precisely and what kind of suggestion is necessary to reach it. – p134

**AIR** – Element that represents the Mind and the Mental Plane. In the Tarot Air is associated to the Planet Uranus, which is represented by the Fool. - ps3,26,28,160,321

**Akashic Records** – Metaphysical term for mythical realm which holds the mystical record of all events that ever were and ever will be. Accessible during dreams or meditative trance.

**AL** - Divine name meaning strength. – p8

**Alchemy** – Exoterically, believed to be a way to turn base metals into gold. Esoterically, Ancient Wisdom taught **Alchemy** as the means to Spiritually transform, using the Tarot exercises of Color and Sound. ps6,8,10,39, 141,153,154,156,158,172, 203,230,298,312,319,323

**Alchemical Symbols** – Detail in the Wheel of Fortune. On the Spokes of the Wheel, in the circle representing the Formative World are the alchemical symbols of Mercury (above); Sulphur (right); Salt (left); and below is the alchemical symbol of Dissolution, identical with the astrological symbol of Aquarius, the Man or Angel in the upper left corner. Man becomes Angel by dissolution, by remaking his body. – p172

**Alchemists** – Practitioners of Alchemy. – p110, 141,154,155,156,172,199,230,271,323,324,335,343

**ALEPH spelled in Hebrew ALP** – Number 1 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 1<sup>st</sup> Mother Letter, which represents the Element Air and means Life Breath. – ps1,3, 19,53,173,175,185,191,226,257, 321,336

**ALIVE** – Occult state when an individual becomes the union of the personality with the Higher Self is brought about when the brain sand, in the Pineal Gland, is fused into the crystal stone. – p21

**Allegories** – Stories, Myths, or legends in which the characters and events are to be understood as representing other things and symbolically expressing a deeper, often Spiritual, moral, or political meaning.

Or the symbolic expression of a deeper meaning through a story or scene acted out by Human , animal, or mythical characters. – ps102,153,212

**Alphabet, Chaldean** – Sacred Alphabet that was origin for the Sacred Hebrew Alphabet of the Israelites – ps99,223,265

**Alphabet, Egyptian** – p149,319

**Alphabet, Greek** – p149,319

- Alphabet, Hebrew** – Sacred Alphabet created when Hebrew mystics expanded the 12 signs of the Zodiac into the 22 letters of the Alphabet – ps9,16, 19,54,67,99,133,135,149,169,172,187,198,199, 224,225,226,236,241,277,291,304,321,337,339
- Alphabet, Sacred Flame** – Sacred aspect of the Hebrew Alphabet where each letter in the Sacred Flame Alphabet included a Yod. – ps149,165,166
- Alethia** – Greek word valued at 64, which means “truth.” The word **Alethia** is a formula for a great many occult truths. – p122
- A-NATURAL** – Note assigned to the Devil and the World. – p233,235,245,282,331
- Ancient Wisdom** – Knowledge/Wisdom belonging to the time before 476 C.E. – ps146,212,346
- Angel of the Sun** – Term for the Archangel Raphael in the Lovers and Temperance. – ps106,198
- Angel-Man** – Term used to represent The Fool as symbolizing the destiny of Human Beings. – p271
- ANGER** – One of the 7 Deadly Sins. In the Tarot Anger’s message is the more violent the emotion, the more it disrupts the work you have already done and you have to begin all over again. – p139
- Animal kingdom** – Kingdom of life before the Human . - ps36,101,229,240,245
- ANIMALS** – Term for the 4 Sacred animals in the Wheel of Fortune. – p171
- Animal-Human s** – term used to signify state of man and woman in the Devil. – p259
- ANKLE** – Detail in the Hanged Man. The hanged Man, hangs by his **Ankle**. the sign of Aquarius presides over the **Ankles**. The **Ankles** direct the feet in the way they should go. When we are directed by Mediation we always go the right way. - p201
- Appetite** – Attribute represented by the Bull in card the Wheel of Fortune. – p38
- Aquarian Age** – Present Age in the Precession of the Equinoxes. Now known as General Precession. In the **Aquarian Age** Humanity, as a race, will begin to become Fourth-Dimensionally Conscious. – ps203, 213,294,325,327
- AQUARIUS** – Sun-sign assigned to the Simple Hebrew letter Tzaddi meaning Fish-Hook and the occult extension of Thought; Meditation. **Aquarius** represents the perfected Man and is assigned to the Star. – ps164,172,185,203,269,271-274,279,280, 299,338,342
- Aquila** – Name of constellation represented by the Eagle in the Wheel of Fortune and the World. **Aquila** the Eagle replaced the Scorpion for the sun-sign Scorpio in the Tarot. – p217
- Archangel Raphael** (The Lovers) ps106,114
- Archangel Gabriel** (Judgement). – ps324,325,330
- Archangel Lucifer** (the Devil) – p236
- Archer, The** – Symbol for the sun-sign Sagittarius. Usually depicted as a Centaur, which is Half-man, Half-horse. – ps162,223,229,231
- Archetypal** – Of the Archetypes. – ps,11,28,46,95, 145,160,193,291,298
- ARCHETYPAL PLANE or World** – Represents the Highest level of the fourfold worlds. Realm where the evolved Human Being possess 15 extensions of perceptions and faculties. – ps11,14, 46, 90,159,164,204,212,246,286,290,295,299, 311,321,324,328,342
- ARCHETYPE** - Image, ideal, or pattern considered to be a universal model. **Archetypes** are found in mythology, literature, and the arts. – ps8,314,321,345
- ARIES** – Sun-sign assigned to the Simple Hebrew letter HeH meaning Window and the faculty of Sight. **Aries** is ruled by Mars and represented by the Emperor. The symbol for **Aries** is the Ram. – ps14, 67,70,180,185,212,229,242,243,309,321,323
- ARMOR, Blue** – Detail in the Emperor meaning Reason arms itself with Memory. – ps71
- ARMOR, Blue** – Detail in the Chariot meaning the charioteer is armed with Memory. – p124
- Aryan Race** – Term used to represent the modern Humanity and Age. **Aryan** was language the Sacred Vedic Scriptures and Sanskrit were written. – p170
- AS ABOVE, SO BELOW** - Hermetic axiom: That which is **Below** corresponds to that which is **Above**, and that which is **Above**, corresponds to that which is **Below**. –ps3,20,29,325
- A-SHARP** - Note assigned to both the Wheel of Fortune and the Star. – ps169,269,282
- Assisi, Saint Francis of** - Born 1181/1182 – died 1226 Founder of the Franciscans, patron saint of animals. – p101
- Astral Body** – Second body that needs purifying symbolized by 3 leaves in the Fool –p5.
- Astral Light** – Term used in Strength, which describes how a Human Being assists in the evolution of Nature, with the creation of new forms and raising the vibration of the matter in its present form, by wielding the **Astral Light**. – ps141,142,143,230, 244,253
- ASTRAL LIGHTS** – Symbol in Strength representing the tool used by the Transformed Heart. – p140
- ASTRAL PLANE** – AKA the Emotional Plane; Emotional level of existence where the counterpart of the Human body **astral body** goes between death and entry into the spirit world. – ps126,164,289
- Astrology** – Mystical Art meaning “to write a Bible in the heavens so that people might know the Laws of their own bodies and Minds. – ps74,75,106,109, 204,224,236,343,347
- Atlantean Age** – Previous Age to the present Aryan Age. – p87

**Atlanteans** – Mystical race using psychic powers to increase their bodily gratifications; believed to have disappeared 11,000 years ago – ps170,259

**ATTAINING EQUILIBRIUM** – Term used in Judgement. Goal achieved by the Subconscious symbolized by the Sword in Justice and the Orange Pennant in the Sun. – ps326

**ATTAINMENT** – 1 of 3 states represented in the Wheel of Fortune, which means the achievement of the goals. – p171

**ATTENTION** – 1<sup>st</sup> mental Step associated with card 1 the Magician. The power to determine cause and effect. – ps20,38,55,85

**Aum** – The sacred syllable that is chanted in Hindu and Buddhist prayers and mantras. – p126

**Avarice** – One of the 7 Deadly Sins. In the Tarot **Avarice** prevents us from opening our Pineal Gland, as it requires us to give up all material standards of valuation. ps138,139

**AWARENESS** – The Prime Energy, the alert spectator, actor in its house, the universe. –ps20, 37,304

**Axiom** - A statement or idea that people accept as self-evidently true. – p29

**AYIN spelled in Hebrew OIN** – Number 16 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 10<sup>th</sup> Simple Letter that represents the sun-sign Capricorn meaning the Eye as an instrument of Sight and represented by the Devil. - ps235,237,238,259,335

**BACK OF THE HEAD** – Symbol for the Hebrew letter Qoph represented by card 18 the Moon. It signifies the place where we see is in the **Back of the Head**, just above the Medulla. – p285

**BACKGROUND** – The color of the **Background** in the cards of the Tarot denotes the first state of Consciousness, which is chiefly instrumental in producing the state depicted in the card. - ps43,121, 124,137,217,261,310,311,337

**BAG** – Detail in the Fool. The **Bag** is eagle-shaped and at the end of the Wand. – p8

**BANNER** – Detail in Judgment that signifies the Magic Square of Mars. – p325

**BAT WINGS** – Detail in the Devil that are there to carry out the Black Background.– ps239,241

**BEAUTY and UGLINESS** – Pair of Opposites that represent Peh in the Tower. – p253

**BEAUTY** – The philosophical term for the 6<sup>th</sup> Emanation of the Life Power.. Meaning the Life Power is always working toward **Beauty**, though through stages of temporary ugliness. – p7

**Bell** - Shape of the top of the pillars in the High Priestess. See clapper...

**Bellows** – Latin meaning for the word Fool. – p9

**Beloved, The** – English definition of the Hebrew name DVD; David with the value of 14 the number of cards in each suit of the Minor Arcana. – p74

**BELOW** – Direction for the High Priestess representing inferior Consciousness. Below also represents Deductive Reasoning. – ps33,137,286

**BELT OF THE ZODIAC** – Detail in the Fool typifying Time and Space. – p8

**BENCH** – Detail in the Empress, which together with the shield, roughly outlines the form of the letter Daleth and represents the corner of the square. – p56

**BETH spelled in Hebrew BITH** - Means House is Number 2 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 1<sup>st</sup> Double Letter. **Beth** represents Mercury and the Magician, and the pair of opposites, Life and Death. – ps19,20,35,169,226,268,301,308,318

**Bethlehem** – Town in Israel, which tradition holds as the birthplace of Jesus. **Bethlehem** translates as “the House of Bread. – ps153,292

**Bhagavad Gita** - An important Sanskrit Hindu scripture. In card 7 The Chariot, the Charioteer, which represents the Higher Self occurs in the Bhagavad-Gita. – p121

**BLACK** – in the Tarot **Black** is to be read at the level of ignorance and sin and also at the level of occult knowledge and practice. p7

**BLACK AND WHITE STRIPES** - Detail in the Hierophant representing the 4 Keys of the 4 planes, and the opposing masculine and feminine. - p101

**BLACK ARMOR** - Detail in Death representing the metal of Mars, which denotes that the Skeleton, kills by a special use of the Mars vibration. – p216

**BLACK BACKGROUND** – Background in a detail in the Chariot and Death – ps124,217

**BLACK CRESCENT** - Detail in the Emperor, meaning the Subconscious & Moon. - p71

**BLACK HALF CUBE** - Detail in the Devil, which symbolize the man and woman in the card are using a half world—the Black of Ignorance. It also represents a half-knowledge of reality. – p240

**BLACK CUSHION** - Detail in the Empress, that represents the Nerve Force being transformed in the Heart Center into a suitable shape to make new brain cells in the thinking lobe of the brain through the Venus Center and the Pituitary body. - p60

**BLACK DRAGON** – Mystical term for the intestinal tract represented by Virgo - p154

**BLACK HAIR** - Detail in the Magician which indicates that his present work is an occult work—that he has mystic perception. – p26

**BLACK PENNANT** - Detail in Death, see also White Rose...ps213,320

**BLACK SQUARE** - Detail in the Devil, which means the measurement of the occult forces of Nature. - p217

**BLACK STEM** - Detail in the Lovers indicating mystic or occult practice that unlocks all the 12 types of Consciousness . - ps109,110

**BLACK TRIANGLE** - Detail in the Chariot, outlining the charioteer's crown, meaning he is the ruler of the forces behind the outward appearance of the stars—the hidden forces of Nature. - p124

**Blake, William** - Born 1757 – died 1827 English poet, painter, and printmaker. Some hold Blake in high regard for his expressiveness and creativity, as well as the philosophical and mystical undercurrents within his work. - ps85,86

**Blavatsky, Madame Helena Petrova** – born 1831 - died 1891, Russian co-founder of Theosophy and the Theosophical Society. - ps36,62,100,127, 178,179,317

**Bloodstream, or circulatory system,** –Allegorically one of the 4 rivers in the Garden of Eden, which represent the 4 fluid systems of the body. p103

**Bloodstream** – ps187,288,307,323

**BLUE** - in Color symbology **Blue** is the Color of the Subconscious and the seas of subjective Mind-Stuff or Cosmic Subconscious.

**BLUE ARMOR** - Detail in the Chariot, indicating the charioteer is armed with Cosmic Memory. p124

**BLUE BACKGROUND** – Detail in the Sun symbolizing the most active agency in bringing about the Collective Intelligence is the Holy Ghost. – p310

**BLUE BLADE** - Detail in Justice indicating the Holy Ghost directs and makes efficient the elimination which the intellectual Subconscious wields in order to reconstruct the body. – p189

**BLUE GROUND** – Detail in the Moon signifying region we connect with during sleep. – ps290,291

**BLUE LAND** - Detail in Temperance signifying planes of Consciousness open to us in sleep– p228

**BLUE MIDDLE REGION** - Detail in the Fool representing the source of information we receive in sleep is the Cosmic Memory. – p6

**BLUE MOUNTAIN** – Detail in Strength, signifying the Cosmic Memory that enables us to manipulate Astral Light p143

**BLUE SPHINX** - Detail in the Wheel of Fortune meaning Memory of all things.– ps171,173

**BLUE WATER** - Detail in the Chariot and Temperance symbolizing Memory and Cosmic Mind Stuff - ps124,227

**BLUE WINGS** - Detail in the Chariot symbolizing the extension of all five senses. – p124

**BLUE-GREEN** – Color of Death denoting the merging of the personal subconscious with the Cosmic Subconscious.

**BLUE-VIOLET** - Color combination assigned to the Devil and the World. Also known as Indigo.

**B-NATURAL** - Note assigned to the Moon. – ps204,285,295

**BOAZ** –Full Name of B on Black Pillar in the High Priestess representing the Intellect. – ps41,48

**Book of Chronicles** – Book in the Old Testament that relates Satan moved King David to take the census of Israel. - p135

**Book of Enoch** – A pseudepigraphical work ascribed to Enoch, the great-grandfather of Noah, which was written between 300 B.C.E. and 100 C.E. The Book describes the fall of the Watchers, the angels who fathered the Nephilim. - p322

**Book of Exodus** – 2nd book of the Old Testament, believed to have been written by the Hebrew prophet Moses. - p305

**Book of Genesis** – 1st book of the Old Testament, believed to have been written by the Hebrew prophet Moses. – ps103,135

**Book of Revelation, The** – Last book of the New Testament. - ps156,198,199,211,253,312,339

**Book of Samuel** – Book in the Old Testament that relates Satan moved King David to take the census of Israel. - p135

**BOOTS** – Detail of the Fool which symbolizes that the Mind is the guide of our feet, telling us where to plant our next step. – p6

**Brain Sand** – Detail in the Magician representing union of the personality with the Higher Self. – p21

**BREASTPLATE** – Detail in the Chariot which symbolizes protection. – p123

**Breath of Life** – Meaning of Hebrew letter Aleph represented by the Fool. – p1

**Brick** - Detail of in the Tower symbolizing the Tower of Babel was built of moonshine or the ideas entirely based on the Subconscious. The 22 layers of **Bricks** in the Tower stand for the 22 Hebrew letters. – ps256,257

**Bright Yellow** – Color of the Fool. – p1

**BROOCH** – Detail in the Chariot, Justice and Temperance. The white **Brooch** of the Charioteer signifies that he took the measurement of the Spiritual forces. - The blue **Brooch** of Justice

symbolizes Justice takes the measurement of the Subconscious forces represented by the High Priestess. - In Temperance the Yellow **Brooch** with a Red Triangle means the mental measurement of the Spiritual forces. – ps189,227

**Buck, Pearl** - Born 1892 — died 1973. She was a prolific American sinologist and Pulitzer Prize-winning American writer. – p186

**Buddha, A** - In Buddhism, somebody who has attained perfect enlightenment. – p170

**Buddha, The** – Gautama Buddha the founder of Buddhism who lived circa 563 to 483 B.C.E. – ps63, 176,243,342

**Bull** – Alternative symbol for the Fool. Also symbol representing the sun-sign Taurus. The word **Bull** has 2 meanings: the lower body as well as the higher

body, meaning that the lower life of the body must be purified for the higher life of the Soul. – ps1,38,79, 80,81,82,83

**BULL, The** – Detail in the Wheel of Fortune and the World. The **Bull** appears as 1 of the 4 Symbols in the corners of both cards, which represent the 4 fixed signs of the Zodiac, which also equate to the 4 elements. – ps175,180,336,337

**BUNCH OF GRAPES** - Detail in the Devil showing the tail of the woman ending in a **Bunch of Grapes**. Indicating is the Subconscious that brings to fruit the desires of the Self-Conscious. – p240

## C

**CAMEL** – Symbol for the Hebrew letter Gimel which is represented by the High Priestess or Memory. The **Camel** represents the Subconscious carrying messages from the thinking lobe of the brain to the rest of the body – ps33,35,41, 82,247

**Canaan** - Land to the west of the Jordan River, later known as Palestine. **Canaan** symbolizes the Purified Intellect in the purified body. – p44

**CANCER** – Sun-sign represented by the Chariot. **Cancer** rules the stomach, female organs or glands, and nourishment. – ps117,118,121,128,129,185, 245,292,323,347

**CANOPY** - Detail in card the Chariot which symbolizes the same thing as the belt of the Zodiac in the Fool. – ps123,124,125,129

**CAPRICORN** - Sun-sign represented by the Devil. **Capricorn's** symbol is the goat, which in astrology is sometimes called the Sea Goat. The Sea represents the Subconscious. – ps158,159,185,235,238,239, 243,245,246,249,294,347

**Capricorn Age** – Age in the Precession of the Equinoxes that succeeds the Aquarian Age. – p294

**Carlyle, Thomas** - Born 1795 – died 1881. He was a Scottish satirical writer whose work was highly influential during the Victorian era. – p326

**Carpenter, Gilbert** – Associated with Mrs. Baker Eddy who spoke of a Human Being's progress is being through both the Subconscious and Self-Conscious—both in alternation. – ps153,189

**CARPET OF GREEN** - Detail in card 6 the Lovers, symbolizing it is the self-conscious and the individual subconscious that helped create the Mountain. – p126

**Carrel, Alexis** - Born 1873 - died 1944 Nobel prize winning French surgeon, biologist and eugenicist. Author of *Man the Unknown*. – p187

**Case, Paul Foster** - Born 1884 – died 1954 American occultist and author on the Tarot and Kabbalah. Founder of the Builders of the Adeptum and onetime member of the Golden Dawn. – ps14,29,47,48,62,64,71,76,96,114,129,137,143,166,1

**Cattle** – The sun-sign of Taurus's symbol of the Bull is associated with **Cattle**. In the Hierophant **Cattle** denotes that your primary earthly possessions are your thoughts, your emotions, and your physical body. – ps81,82

**Cerebrospinal nervous system, The** – In vertebrate anatomy, one of the two main divisions of the nervous system, supplying impulses to the body's heart muscles... controls the action of the glands; the functions of the respiratory, circulatory, digestive, and urogenital systems... Controlled by nerve centers in the lower part of the brain. – ps102,117,202,284

**Chakras** – The 7 energy centers of the body that are represented by the Seven Sacred Planets – ps19,21,60,91,226,282,295,330

**Chaldean** – Of an ancient Semitic people who lived in **Chaldea** in southern Babylonia, where they were the dominant ethnic group during the 8th and 7th centuries B.C.E. – ps99,223,265

**Chariot** – Detail in the Chariot representing protection – ps123,128,160

**CHARIOT, THE** – Card 7 representing Receptivity-Will, the Moon, sun-sign Cancer, orange-yellow, note D-Sharp, and direction East-Below – ps83, 99,108,117-128,143,189, 223,227,253,256,260,270,323,333

**Charioteer** - Detail in card the Chariot which is a higher aspect of The Fool—not in his aspect of descending into matter to become the personality, but now as the tenant of the body which the personality has finally perfected for his occupation. – ps113, 118,121,122,123,124,125,140,143,160,227,256,260,275,312,315,322,323,333,337

**CHETH spelled in Hebrew ChITH** - Means Fenced Field. It is Number 8 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 4th Simple Letter. Assigned to the Chariot, **Cheth** represents the occult extension of Speech which means “making magic”. – ps117,118,256

**Child, The** - Term in the Hermit representing the Light born from the darkness.- p159

**Christ-Child, The** – Archetype connected to several cards, symbolizing the divine offspring of the mystic union between the Pituitary Body and the Pineal Gland, or the Self-Conscious and the Cosmic Subconscious – ps62,304,312

**Christ-Consciousness** –Microcosmically the **Christ-Consciousness** represents the Spiritual development of the individual. Macrocosmically, the **Christ-Consciousness** represents the Universal Christ – ps57,73,125,126,129,157,174,194,240, 305,311,312,315,324

**Christian Science** - A Church founded by Mary Baker Eddy, who believed illness should be

overcome or managed through faith and religious observances alone. – ps52,135,254,259

**Christian Scientist** – p82

**Christian Theology** - Christian theologians use biblical exegesis, rational analysis and argument to understand, explain, test, critique, defend or promote Christianity. – ps135,136

**Chyle** - Detail in the Hermit meaning a milky fluid consisting of lymph and emulsified fat that forms in the small intestine during digestion. Alchemists believed it was the essence of food extracted by the digestive fluids, and the necessary elements for body building. – ps154,230

**CIRCLE** - Detail in several cards symbolizing among other things, the superconscious and the number 22. – ps56,58,189

**CIRCLE above the CROSS**- Detail in the Empress. The circle is the sign of the Zodiac and refers to the self-conscious. The cross below means the sacrifice of the lower to the higher. – p56

**Clapper** - Detail that goes with the **Bell** on the top of the pillars in the High Priestess. The **Clapper** represents the Will, or the self-conscious. The bowl of the **Bell** symbolizes the subconscious, which is useless without the **clapper**. – ps42,87

**PISCES** - Sun-sign assigned to the Simple Hebrew letter Qoph meaning the Back of the Head and the occult extension of Sleep. **Pisces** which is ruled by Neptune is represented by card 18 the Moon. – ps82, 164,180,185,200,285,289,298,299

**Pituitary Body** – Alternative term for the Moon Center represented by card 2 the High Priestess. – ps34,40,41,51,53, 59,60,85,88,125,140-142,170, 186,197,212,215,228,230,275,276,286,304,307, 310,322,323,339

**PITUITARY GLAND** - Sometimes called the “master gland,” the **Pituitary gland** controls “target glands” and releasing hormones, it controls the activity of the other endocrine glands. The High Priestess, represents both the normal and subnormal functions of the **Pituitary**. – ps21,33,34,35,36,43,44, 51,60,81,92,142,186,187,197,212,228,230,275,276, 286,304,307,310,322,323,339

**Plant kingdom** - Kingdom of life that the Animal Kingdom evolved from. – p84

**Plato** – Greek Philosopher who lived approximately 428—347 B.C.E. One of the most creative and influential thinkers in Western philosophy, Plato said “Ideas are really the things that we see on a higher plane if we have the Spiritual perception.” – p86

**Pluto** – Outer Planet discovered in 1930. **Pluto** is the higher octave of the Planet Mars and rules the sun-sign Scorpio, assigned to card 13 Death. **Pluto** wasn't originally assigned to a Mother Letter, but many decks replace Vulcan with **Pluto** for card 20 Judgement..- ps11,209,211,215,317,330

**Pneuma** – One of 2 Greek words for Spirit that mean breath. **Pneuma** is the root word for pneumonia and pneumatic tires. – p9

**Pollyanna** - An unrealistically optimistic person. – ps123,242

**POMEGRANATE** - Detail on the Veil behind the priestess in card 2 the High Priestess considered a universal Feminine Symbol because of its numerous seeds. – p43

**POOL** - Detail in cards 17 the Star, 14 Temperance and 2 the High Priestess. It represents the Cosmic Mind-Stuff. – ps228,276,291,292

**Pope** - Head of the Roman Catholic Church and in the Tarot an archetype for a Religious leader or High Priest represented by card 5 the Hierophant. – p87

**Prana** - Hindu word meaning breath, which Hindu's believe is the universal energy of the Life Power **Prana** can also be described as Cosmic Electricity. – ps9,141,142,255

**PRIDE** - One of the 7 Deadly Sins. There are 2 types of **Pride**, virtuous or authentic **Pride**, which is interpreted as magnanimity. The 2<sup>nd</sup> type associated with vanity or narcissism is detrimental to Spiritual Development. – ps122,138,139,258,264

**Prometheus** – A Titan in Greek mythology who became a hero to Human kind for stealing fire from the gods to give it to us. – p236

**PROP or SUPPORT** - Symbol for the Simple Hebrew letter Samekh assigned to card 14 Temperance. – ps221,223

**Prostatic Ganglion** – Physiological term for the Mars Center, which is located between the spine and the naval. – p252

**Protestant** - A member or adherent of any denomination of the Western Christian church that rejects papal authority. Beginning with Martin Luther and the Reformation in the 16th century. – ps44,200

**Proverbs, Book of** - a book of the Bible that consists of the proverbs of wise men, including Solomon. – p6

**Psalms, Book of** - A book of the Bible that consists of 150 poems and hymns, many traditionally attributed to King David. – p153

**PShO** - One of the Hebrew words for sin. It is connected to another word in Hebrew meaning *Divine Influence* that is spelled ShPO. – ps256,257

**Psychic Powers, lower** – Powers driven by instinct. – ps197,290

**Psychic Vision** – Otherwise known as Clairvoyance. – p183

**Psychoanalyst** – A practitioner of a psychological theory and therapeutic method developed by Sigmund Freud. – p112  
**Psychologists** – Professionals who practice Psychology. – ps10,11,42,45,122,154,155,178  
**Purgatory** - In Roman Catholic doctrine, of a place where souls remain until they have expiated their sins and can go to heaven. – p266  
**PURIFIED DESIRE** – The desire is purified by the balanced action of the conscious and the Subconscious. – ps5,22

## Q

**QOPH spelled in Hebrew QVD** - Number 19 in Hebrew Alphabet and the 12<sup>th</sup> Simple Letter that stands for the occult extension of the function of Sleep. **Qoph** signifies the Solar Energy entering the spinal column and is represented by card 18 the Moon. – ps197,204,283,285,288,295,303  
**Quick** – Occult alternative term for Alive, which is what a person becomes after the union of the personality with the Higher Self. – ps20,21,172,212,274,321  
**Quicken/ing** – Occult term for the result the effect of Color and Sound has in changes to the etheric body. – ps69,79,102,105,215,323  
**Quick Silver** - Mercury is **Quicksilver** (Superconsciousness) and makes quick in us the Holy Ghost. – p200

## R

**Rabbi** - The leader of a Jewish congregation, or the chief religious official of a synagogue. A Rabbi is also a scholar qualified to teach or interpret Jewish law.  
**RAISED HAND, THE** - Detail in card 15 the Devil. The **Raised Hand** of The Devil blessing the man and woman is open wide as if to say: “You see, all there is to life is the desire for sensation; there is nothing else.” – ps239,262  
**Rajas** - Hindu term for 1 of 3 qualities of matter. In Tarot it corresponds to Sulphur and the self-consciousness. – ps90,172  
**Ram** - Symbol for the sun-sign Aries. – ps70,243  
**RAM’S HEADS, 4** - Detail in card 4 the Emperor, symbolizing that the Emperor has made his union with the Higher Self. – p70,76  
**Raphael Sanzio** - Born 1483 – died 1520 Italian painter and architect of the High Renaissance. - p54  
**RAUCH or RVCh** – Hebrew word that can sometimes stand for the Self-Conscious, as in **RVCh (Rauch)**, which means Life Breath. “R” (the sun) and “Ch” (the Moon) in us are united by the Self-Conscious. Sometimes it stands for the body. The

body is our link with the Higher Self. It communicates with us through the body. – p79  
**Rays, 14** - Detail in card 0 the Fool. The **14 Rays** of the White Sun mean it was the work of Reason creating the world. The **14 Rays** designate how creation began by the pouring down of the mental images of the Spirit by the employment of Reason. The sea into which the **14 Rays** come is the Mind. – ps74,321  
**REASON** – 4th mental Step associated with card 4 The Emperor. –ps23,41,57,68-74,79,84,85,86,88,100,101,107,117,118,136,170,186,202,237,239,243,253,255-257,260,276,286,292,306,308,309,311,310,311,320,321,327  
**RECEPTIVITY-WILL** - This is the 7<sup>th</sup> and last principle of Consciousness represented by card 7 the Chariot. **Receptivity-Will** is a combination of all 6 previous Principles of Consciousness and represents the perfected body. – ps119,130,223,270,341  
**RED** - In the Tarot the Color **Red** stands for desire and action. All action is prompted by desire and if there were no desire, we would never act. **Red** stands for the Mars vibration and for action. **Red** also means sex force, and that when Man has opened his Pineal Gland, he uses the sex force in the head..  
**RED BIRD** - Detail in card 17 the Star. The **Red Bird** perched on the top of the thinking lobe of the brain is the Ibis, or the fish catcher, and hence the Fish Hook. – p276  
**RED CROSS** - Detail in card 20 Judgment, which may be taken at many levels. For instance, the **Red Cross** can stand for the 4 figures in the card: the Angel, the self-conscious, the subconscious, and the Christ-Consciousness. – p325  
**RED CUSHION** - Detail in card 3 the Empress, symbolizing the Mars Center, which is present everywhere in the body. – p60  
**RED FEATHER** - Detail in card 0 The Fool signifying what the mystic or occultist call “lifting the sex force to the head.” – p8  
**RED FILLET** - Detail running through the Dancer’s Hair in card 21 the World, symbolizing the Mind and mental plane made active.- p338  
**RED MANTLE** - Detail in card 16 the Tower typifying that the only desire of the self-conscious is to live in the body. – p260  
**RED RIBBON** - Detail in card 3 the Empress. A **Red Ribbon** runs through the Empress’s Crown of 12 Stars, meaning that Venus has control of the 12 states of Consciousness. The **Red Ribbon** stands for the Mars vibration. – p56  
**Red Robe** - Detail in several cards throughout the Tarot. The inner lining of card 0 the Fool’s **Red Robe** signifies desire and action, which springs from desire. In card 1 The Magician the **Red Robe** of

Spirit denotes The Magician's desire to make his body more capable of receiving the Superconscious vibration. - The Emperor's **Red Robe** means desire, and the result of desire is action. - The voluminous **Red Robe of Action** in card 11 Justice represents the intellectual Subconscious acting under occult instructions from the self-conscious. - ps7,26,71,187

**RED ROSE** - Detail in card 3 the Empress, symbolizing desire or activity can only proceed from desire and always flowers out of the image.-p59

**RED-ORANGE** - In the Tarot **Red-Orange** represents the Higher Self, or the Hierophant's Color. **Red-Orange** is the color of Reason mixed with Yellow. When the Reason acts in accordance with the Superconscious, it is **Red-Orange**..

**RED WINGS** - Detail on the Angel in card 6 the Lovers denoting that he is full of Desire to be One with the Universal Energy.- ps107, 124,239,241

**REFLECTION** - Outstanding note of card 18 The Moon, which denoted that the Moon Reflecting the light of the Sun symbolizes the Subconscious Reflecting the Self-Conscious. - p289

**Regeneration** - The Christian term for Transformation. **Regeneration** comes when the purified Will and purified body work together as one. - ps138,155,165,213,214,290,306,307,312

**REMORSE** - One of 2 destructive emotions which should never be indulged in and that we should be on our guard against all the time. - p119

**Renaissance** - The cultural and religious spirit that characterized the Renaissance, including the decline of Gothic architecture, the revival of classical culture, the beginnings of modern science, and geographic exploration. - ps75,76,338

**RENEWING INTELLIGENCE** - Intelligence represented by card 19 The Sun. **Renewing Intelligence** is that which tempts you to use your body wrongly also opens the door to True Wisdom, when used rightly. - ps235,236,238

**RESH spelled in Hebrew RISH** - Meaning Face or Head is Number 20 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 6th Double Letter. **Resh** represents the Sun and card 19 The Sun. **Resh**, which means the Head stands for the equilibrated heart. It is also the sign and symbol for the pair of opposites, Fruitfulness and Sterility. - ps19,223,226,303,304,333,338

**Response, Law of** - The 2<sup>nd</sup> in a series of Laws symbolized by the 2<sup>nd</sup> row of the Tarot Tableau. Represented by the Hermit, the **Law of Response** transfers to the self-conscious Mind the flash of Intuition sent by the Higher Self. - ps223,224

**RESURRECTION** - Term used in several cards, including card 13 Death and card 20 Judgment. - ps126,213,235,273,320,321,324,327

**REVERSAL** - In the Tarot card 12, the Hanged Man represents **Reversal**. The continual practice of Meditation, which is the suspension of the personal Mind will result in an entire **Reversal** of the usual way of thinking. - ps175,269,277

**Reversal, Law of** - The 5th in a series of Laws symbolized by the 2<sup>nd</sup> row of the Tarot Tableau. Represented by the Hanged Man. The **Law of Reversal** reverses the desires of the personal self for the desires of the Cosmic Self. - p223

**REWARDING INTELLIGENCE** - Intelligence represented by card 10 the Wheel of Fortune. **Rewarding Intelligence** assists in understanding how a thing happens to you as a thing apart. You see what its cause was, and you see that it is still becoming a cause to something in the future. - ps169,174

**Rider-Waite Deck** - Created by A.E Waite and Pamela Coleman Smith. This is the deck *The Rabbi's Tarot* uses to interpret the Ancient Wisdom or the *Mysteries*.

**RIGHT FOOT** - Detail in card 12 in which the Hanged is suspended by his **Right Foot**, denoting that it is the self-conscious that must do the thinking for him if he is to suspend himself in this position: it must not be prescribed by the appetites, emotions, and ambitions of the body. - p201

**RIGHT HAND** - In the symbolism of the Tarot, what is held in the left Hand is automatic, and what is held in the **Right Hand** is the more important, the conscious activity. - ps24,76,160,306,336,338

**RISING SUN** - Detail in card 13 Death and card 19 the Sun. In Death the **Rising Sun** is this deathless Solar Body or the awakened Pineal Gland and Pituitary Body; both functioning as one. - This is again symbolized by the **Rising Sun** in card 19 the Sun. - ps212,215,290,320

**River Jordan** - River in Southwest Asia which flows into the Dead Sea. Believed by many to be the river that John the Baptist baptized Jesus in.- p325

**ROBE OF IGNORANCE** - Detail in card 0 The Fool signifying that for the Life Power to come down into flesh, He must put on the **Robe of Ignorance**, which is Black. - ps7,241

**Rome, Romans, and Roman, Ancient** - Located on the Tiber River in Italy, **Rome** was the capital city of the Roman Empire from 27 B.C.E. until it was sacked in 410 C.E. - ps19,33,67,79,83,99,117, 133,149-151,169,171,185,193,197,204,205,223, 235,253,269,270,294,299,303,319,322,330,333

**Rosicrucians** - An international organization concerned with esoteric wisdom derived from ancient mystical and philosophical doctrines. - ps157,174, 175,319

**ROTA** - Detail in card 10 the Wheel of Fortune. On the outermost Wheel, alternating with letters IHVH,

are the Roman letters **ROTA**. As The Wheel turns, these letters read **ROTA TARO ORAT TORA ATOR** meaning “The Wheel of Tarot teaches or speaks the Laws of Nature.” – p171

**ROTATION Law of** - The 3rd in a series of Laws represented by the 2<sup>nd</sup> row of the Tarot Tableau. Symbolized by the Wheel of Fortune, this law reveals that all action is cyclic; it begins, it grows, works its pattern up to its completion and ends. – p169

## S

**Sacral Center** – Alternative term for Saturn Center where the Serpent Force in the body lies coiled at the base of the spine. – ps139,212

**SAGITTARIUS** - Sun-sign assigned to the Simple Hebrew letter Samekh meaning Prop or Support and for the mental modification of Wrath assigned to card 14 Temperance. **Sagittarius** which is ruled by Jupiter’s symbol is the archer or centaur. – ps75,162, 163,185,223,229,230,231,242

**SAILBOAT** - Detail in card 13 Death. The **Sail Boat** symbolizes a tiny segment of the Mars Vibration deflected from its natural destination in the Mars Center. This is transmuted in the heart in a kind of nerve force which can build the better brain. – p216

**Saint Francis** – Saint **Francis of Assisi** 1182-1226. Italian mystic and preacher, who founded the Franciscans Order in the Catholic Church, famous for his purity and love of animals. – p101

**Saint James** – Brother of Jesus and head of the Jerusalem Church. *The Book of James* in the New Testament is attributed to him. – p191

**Saint King James** – English King who ruled from 1566 to 1625. Most famous for having the Scriptures translated into the King James Bible. -p270

**Salt** - In alchemy, one of the 3 alchemical principles or the sea of scintillating Mind-Stuff called First Matter. **Salt** can be either a quality of matter or a quality of Consciousness. – p172

**SAMEKH spelled in Hebrew SMK** - Means Prop or Support and is Number 15 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 9th Simple Letter. **Samekh** represents the sun-sign Sagittarius ruled by Jupiter and card 14 Temperance. Standing for the mental modification of Wrath, the character **Samekh** is a modification of the circle and said to represent the serpent swallowing its own tail. – ps133,187,188,197,198,221,223,224, 253,303,323-325

**Samson** –Herculean figure in the Old Testament, who is granted tremendous strength through the Spirit, concentrated in his hair.- p26,241

**Sanctuary, Gate of the** – Term referred to in card 2 the High Priestess, referring to the Pituitary Body, as “The **Gate**,” to the Pineal Gland. – p40

**Santayana, George** – Born 1863 - died 1952 Spanish philosopher, essayist, poet, and novelist. Famous for the saying “Those who cannot remember the past, are condemned to repeat it”. – p152

**SATURN** - One of the Seven Sacred Planets, which is represented by card 21 the World. **Saturn** symbolizes the condensing power, the limiting power, which makes the void take shape. **Saturn** represents the Administrative Intelligence, which directs the operation of all 7 planets. **Saturn** comes to its highest expression in Libra.– ps48,63,73,120, 124,158,162,164,165,178,190,216,233,237,238,239, 245,246,249,272,273,280,282,295,315,331,334,335, 336,339,343

**Saturn Center** – Term for base chakra where the Serpent Force lies coiled. It governs all the other centers by increasing or diminishing their supply of the vivifying Kundalini. – ps110,139,163,286,332

**Saturn Vibration, The** - The **Saturn Vibration** restricts, binds, limits, and sets problems which we must solve. – ps190,216,217,237,273,336

**Saturn Cross** – Detail in card 4 The Emperor concerning the handle of the Emperor’s Scepter, which is the symbol of the Empress. The T-Cross or **Saturn Cross** means that he (Reason) rules through his wife (Imagination), who carries out and makes fruitful his image, but also that he sternly controls those images. – p73

**Satva** - Hindu term for one of 3 qualities of matter, which are Satva, Tamas, and Rajas. **Satva** is the tendency of matter to collect into form. – p90

**Scales** - Symbol for the sun-sign Libra. – ps55,185, 187,192,194,223

**SCALES** - Detail in card 11 Justice. The **Scales** are instruments for weighing and measuring, and according to their findings she makes readjustments by which she secures equilibrium. Justice trims off with the Sword where she weighs off with the **Scales**. – ps186-189,191,223,336

**Scepter** - Detail in 3 cards, 3 the Empress, 4 the Emperor, and 5 the Hierophant. A **Scepter** in the cards means dominion. – ps56,58,72,73,76,90,187, 194,202,242,260,311,312

**Scimitar** - An Arab or Turkish sword with a curved blade that broadens out as it nears the point. The letter Zain, meaning Sword and represented by card 7 the Lovers looks like an Eastern **Scimitar**. – p99

**SCORPIO** - Sun-sign assigned to the Simple Hebrew letter Nun meaning Fish stands for the occult extension of Motion or Change. **Scorpio** ruled by Pluto, the higher octave of Mars, is assigned to card 13 Death. – ps176,185,211,212,217,205, 210,233, 235,227,321,330

**Scorpion** - Symbol for the sun-sign Scorpio. – ps211,213,214,217,240

**SCROLL of the Law** - Detail mentioned in card 11 Justice concerning the High Priestess. – ps186, 198  
**SEAS or WATER** - Symbol for the Mother Hebrew letter Mem represented by card 12 the Hanged Man, denoting the Cosmic Mind-Stuff and Emotions. – p197

**Secret, Great Magical** – Is the union of the power of the Earth with the power of the Sun. – p246

**Secret Wisdom** - Ancient **Secret Wisdom** of the Hebrews.- ps5,79,149,151,235-238

**SELF-CONSCIOUS** – Represented by card 1 the Magician. The Self-conscious in us which is aware and wills (by Will, we mean the right of choice). The **Self-Conscious** makes the image and instructs the Subconscious to carry it out. – ps27,40,89,107,227

**SELF-PITY** – One of 2 destructive emotions which should never be indulged in and we should be on our guard against all the time. – p119

**Serpent** - Symbol for the Simple Hebrew letter Teth represented by card 8 Strength. It means the transmuted sex force and the reproductive power of each cell in your body. – ps131,133

**Serpent Fire** – Alternative term for Kundalini that brings about a union of the personal Consciousness with the Superhuman Consciousness, by making active the Pineal Gland, and by extending the perception of the five senses so that they can perceive matter on the higher planes. – p110

**Serpent Force** – Alternative term for Kundalini residing in the lowest 3 chakras. Through Imagination the **Serpent Force** is lifted to the Heart and changed into nerve force. Through this transformation the Scorpion becomes the Eagle. – ps110,212,216

**Serpent Power** - Alternative term for Kundalini, that is the concealed potency existing inside and outside the body and everything in the world. It is represented by the 3 Hebrew letters Teth, Lamed and Samekh. – p139,140

**Seven Centers** – Otherwise known as the 7 Interior Stars or Chakras. – ps189,277,322

**Seven Planes** – Hindu teaching that there are **Seven Planes** of existence. Tarot and the Secret Wisdom of the Hebrews condense the **Seven Planes** into 3. – p5

**Seven Spirits before the Throne** – New Testament term for the Hebrew God “Jehovah” as the Seven Elohim, or He of the Seven Elohim. – p91

**SEVEN TREFOILS** - Detail in card 0 the Fool and card 5 the Hierophant. In the Fool they represent the 7 great phases of the Life Power’s activity and correspond to the 7 centers of the body. The **Seven Trefoils** on the Hierophant’s Tiara symbolize the 7 forces of the Physical Plane. – ps7,91

**Seven White Stars** - Detail in card 17 the Star, representing the seven purified Centers, and how

their perfect action, when purified, produces the Eighth Star. – p275

**Sex-Union or Touch– 12 functions** – One of the 12 occult extensions represented by the 12 Simple Hebrew Letters attributed to card 9 the Hermit and the Zodiacal sign Virgo, the Virgin. – p224

**Shakespeare, William** 1564-1616 - English playwright and poet, recognized in much of the world as the greatest of all dramatists born.– ps54,61,124

**SHELF** - Detail in card 0 the Fool. The **Shelf** is made of a flaky formation and is Colored largely Reddish shading into Yellow and into Gray to symbolize that we can flake off our Subconscious or make the matter less and less dense by desire and action instigated by the Self-Conscious. – p6

**SHIN spelled in Hebrew ShIN** - Means Tooth or Fang and is Number 21 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Mother Letter. **Shin** is assigned to card 20 Judgment, the Element Fire and the esoteric Planet Vulcan or Pluto. – ps317,319

**Shinar** – Allegorical plain in the Old Testament where the Tower of Babel was built. **Shinar** means, emotions. – p258

**SIGHT** - Symbol represented by card 4 the Emperor and card 15 the Devil. The Emperor means **Sight** itself, independent of any other instrument. The Devil’s Hebrew Letter Ayin means the Eye as the instrument of **Sight**. – ps65,67,74,91,224,233,242

**Sight – 12 functions** – One of the 12 extensions of faculties represented by the 12 Simple Hebrew letters. The occult extension of **Sight** is connected to Reason or The Emperor. – p224

**SILVER CROWN** - Detail in card 2 the High Priestess symbolic of the Feminine Principle, which is at the root of all things. – p40

**Simony** – One of the sins that Jesus said was the worse sin. Simony, which derived its name from Simon Magus was the buying or selling of Spiritual things, as in paying for offices or positions in the hierarchy of a church. – p138

**SIMPLE LETTER** – The **Simple Letters** are the 12 Hebrew letters represent the 12 signs of the Zodiac. All the **Simple Letters** indicate an extension of a sense, faculty, or a function of the body. – ps54, 67,79,99,117,133,149,185,211,223,235,269,295

**SIRIUS** – Astronomically **Sirius** is the brightest star visible in the night sky and part of the constellation Canis Major. In card 21 the World, **Sirius** is referred to as the Logos of the previous Solar System, which correlates to the 5<sup>th</sup> Dimension. – ps275,339

**SIX-POINTED STAR** - Detail in card 9 the Hermit’s Lantern symbolizing that when the personality has interlaced his 2 triangles, he has made himself equal to his Higher Self and becomes permanently united with his Higher Self. – p160

**SKELETON RIDER** - Detail in card 13 Death, which refers to the fact that each thing must die in order that life may enter another form. – p216

**SKIRT** - Detail in card 7 The Chariot. The **Skirt** of the Charioteer tells you that he is furthering evolution by the magic creation of forms. - p125

**SKULL** - Detail in card 6 the Lovers. The Trunk of the Tree in which the Serpent is ascending is the Spine. The Foliage of the Tree is the **Skull**. - p110

**SLEEP, occult extension** - Symbol for Simple Hebrew letter Qoph associated to card 18 the Moon.– p295

**SLOTH** – One of the 7 Deadly Sins – **Sloth** keeps you from opening the Pineal Gland, because to open the Pineal Gland requires constant, vigilant work upon yourself. – p138

**Smell - 12 functions** - One of the 12 extensions of faculties or **Smell** on the Mental Plane, symbol of card 6 the Lovers.– ps91,99,134,217

**Smith, Pamela Coleman** - Born 1878 - died 1951 English artist, illustrator, and writer. She is best known for designing the Rider-Waite-Smith deck for Arthur Edward Waite.

**Snake symbol** - Symbol represented by 3 Hebrew letters, Teth, Lamed, and Samekh corresponding to cards 8 Strength, 11 Justice, and 14 Temperance. These 3 cards deal primarily with the Subconscious and Superconscious. – p133

**SOLAR ENERGY** – **Solar Energy** is the power flowing through us and constitutes the life of all things. **SPIRITUAL MAN** - Principal idea in the Ancient Mysteries that Man, by his own work upon himself, died and was born again into a higher type of Man, represented by the Magician. – p20

**Spiritual Pride** – Religious administrators with superior attitude when comparing themselves with non-attendants demonstrate spiritual pride. – p122

**Splendor** – (See Glory) – p7

**STABLE INTELLIGENCE** - Intelligence represented by card 12 the Hanged Man. **Stable Intelligence** refers to the fixed, firm, unshakable Consciousness. We can acquire it by the habit of occult Meditation. – ps197,198

**STAR, THE** - Card 17 representing the occult extension of the function of Thought. It also represents Uranus, sun sign Aquarius, violet, note A-Sharp, symbol water-carrier and fishhook, and direction South Above – ps124,197,240,269-282, 291,303,304,306

**Stellar Fire** – Alternative term in card 14 Temperance, and 20 Judgement for the Astral Light. – ps230,321

**Understanding** - The philosophical term for one of the 10 instantaneous emanations of the Life Power meaning It is the Perfect **Understanding** of every condition and situation. – p7

**URANUS** – **Uranus** was assigned to Aleph, card 0 the Fool, which is the Mother Letter for Air. In Astrology **Uranus** rules Aquarius. – ps1,3,11,14,28, 67,162,164,165,267,271,272,280,314,328

**VAV spelled in Hebrew VV** - Means Nail and is Number 6 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Simple Letter. **Vav or Vau** represents the sun-sign Taurus ruled by Venus and card 5 the Hierophant. – ps77, 79,80,81,86,241

**VEIL** - Detail in card 2 the High Priestess and card 11 Justice. – ps42,43,123,186,187,333,338,340

**VENUS** - One of the Seven Sacred Planets, which is the Individual Subconscious and the Creative Imagination. **Venus** directly represents 3 cards in the Major Arcana; 3 the Empress, 5 the Hierophant, and 11 Justice. **Venus Symbol** - Circle above a Cross. The circle stands for the Superconscious and the Cross stands for the Self-Conscious. – ps56,58,88

The direction **West-Above** represents the body of manifestation controlled by the Mind as the agent of the Higher Self, until it is thereby fitted to come directly under the control of the Angel Himself. – ps223,235,264

**WEST-BELOW** - Direction assigned to the Simple Letter Ayin, the Planet Saturn and card 15 the Devil. – ps237,245

**WHEEL OF FORTUNE, THE** - Card 10 representing the Cosmic cycles of Involution and Evolution. It also represents Jupiter, violet, note A-Sharp, symbol grasping hand, and direction West – ps82,83,169-182,186,198,253,260,270,275,277,337

**WHEEL, THE** - Detail in cards 0 the Fool, 4 the Emperor, 7 the Chariot, and 10 the Wheel of Fortune. The **Wheel** in general is a symbol for the cycles of involution and evolution. – ps7,11,14,73,105,123,125,163,169,180,182,275,309,311,343

**WHIRLING CROSS or Cross of Nature** – Ancient sacred symbol representing a condition where the self-conscious deliberately works through the subconscious to express the One Will. – p277

**WHIRLING ACTION** - Card 10 the Wheel of Fortune represents **Whirling Action**. – p174

**White Adept** – Someone who never uses their personal Will. – p23

**WHITE** - In the Tarot **White** is the Color of Spirit. Whenever you see White in the 22 cards, it means belonging to Abstract Thought, or to the Spiritual Plane.

**WHITE BACKGROUND** – Detail in 4 cards, 5 the Hierophant, 13 Death, 12 the Hanged Man, and 14 Temperance. A **White Background** depicts the action of Spiritual Forces. – p226

**WHITE BOOK** - Detail in card 10 the Wheel of Fortune signifying the Divine will is carried out on Earth. – ps83,171,186,336

**WHITE CROSS** - Detail in card 2 the High Priestess symbolizing Spiritual Will. – p42,48,198

**WHITE CUBE** - Detail in card 2 the High Priestess, signifying the purpose of the subconscious is to keep you in balance. – p41

**WHITE CUFFS** – Detail in card 7 the Chariot. The charioteer's **White Cuffs** sevenfold fluting refers to the 7 chakras being purified and at their highest Spiritual rate of vibration. – p124

**WHITE DRESS** - Detail in card 7 the Chariot and card 8 Strength denoting the Spirit. – p143

**WHITE HAIR** - Detail in card 4 the Emperor and 12 the Hanged Man alluding to the Ancient of Days. – ps73,201

**WHITE HORSE** - Detail in card 13 Death, symbolizing the Spirit. – ps211,213,216,217,260,320

**WHITE LIGHT** – Designation for the Force from Above utilized to transfuse and Transform. – ps22,23,25,27,35,44,73,143,156,187

**WHITE ROSE** - Detail in card 0 the Fool and card 13 Death. In The Fool the **White Rose** is the symbol of purified desire. - The **White Rose** on the Black Pennant designates the 15 extensions of perceptions and faculties Man will possess when he becomes the Angel. – ps4,5,8,22,211,213,217,320

**WHITE SQUARE** - Detail in card 7 the Chariot and card 20 Judgment. The **White Square** on the charioteer's breastplate means the measurement of the White Spiritual forces to use on the 4 Planes. The **White Square** on the Banner in Judgement means the Angel equips the 3 below him with the measurement of the Spiritual forces. – ps124,325

**WHITE STARS** - Detail in card 17 the Star 7 **White Stars** represent the 7 purified Centers. – ps275,277

**WHITE SUN** - Detail in card 0 the Fool and card 13 Death. The **White Sun** symbolizes the Spiritual, or White, Plane. – ps5,8,74,216,278,321

**WHITE TABS** - Detail in card 5 the Hierophant. representing the functioning of Abstract Thought on all 4 planes. – p88

**Whitman, Walt** – Born 1819 – died 1892 American poet, essayist, journalist, and Humanist. During the transition between Transcendentalism and realism, he incorporated both views in his works. – p224

**WILL** - The philosophical term for one of the 10 instantaneous emanations of the Life Power meaning the Life Power is, in itself, both unmanifested and manifest. The latter is required to produce the universe. – p7

**Will** – Term throughout the Tarot, which concerns both the self-conscious and Divine **Will**. – ps20,57,89,119,151,199,200,201,217,258,260-262,275,290,306,312,313

**WILL, INTELLIGENCE of** - Intelligence represented by card 9 the Hermit. The Intelligence of Will is the state of Consciousness of blissful unity with the Father. – ps149,152

**WILL, SUPREME** - The Hermit represents the **Supreme Will**, and the **Supreme Will** is the eternal urge to evolve, to change, to exhibit variety. – p151

**Windbag** – The root for the word Fool means “bellows”. – ps9,10

**WINDOW** - Symbol for the Simple Hebrew letter HeH represented by card 4 the Emperor meaning Reason. – ps67,288,292

**WISDOM**— The philosophical term for one of the 10 instantaneous emanations of the Life Power meaning that it is the unfailing **Wisdom**, which knows every principle of reality. – p7

**WISDOM and FOLLY or Knowledge and Ignorance** - Pair of opposites represented by the Double Letter Daleth assigned to card 3 the Empress signifying that the individual subconscious either receives **Wisdom or Folly** from us. – ps51,53

**WITHIN or CENTER** - Direction assigned to the Double Letter Tau, Saturn and card 21 The World.

**Within or Center** represents the culmination of the powers of the Empress in us. – ps333,339

**WOLF** - Detail in card 18 the Moon symbolizing the subconscious. –ps290,293

**WOMAN** - In the Tarot, the **Woman** is the subconscious. – ps137,142,260,262,276,277,292,325,326

**WOMAN in THE STAR** - Detail in card 17 the Star, represents the Empress fructifying the land by pouring Water (Cosmic Memory) on it. – ps276,277

**Work and Action – 12 functions** - One of the 12 occult extensions represented by the 12 Simple Hebrew Letters. **Work and Action** is also the Symbol for card 11 Justice. – p183,185

**WORLD, THE** - Card 21 representing the most exalted state possible to human beings. It also represents Saturn, blue-violet, note A-Natural, symbol cross and signature, and direction Center – ps82,83,158,159,186,190,237,238,239,272,273,310,333-345

**Wrath– 12 functions** - One of the 12 occult extensions represented by the 12 Simple Hebrew Letters, which is also the Symbol for card 14 Temperance. In Temperance it represents the mental modification of **Wrath**. – ps221,223,224

**WREATH** - Detail in cards 0 the Fool, 3 the Empress, 7 the Chariot, 8 Strength, 19 the Sun, and 21 the World. In The Fool the **Wreath** designate the transformed Self-Conscious and the transformed Subconscious. - The Empress’ **Wreath** is the nearest thing we have to sunlight. - The Charioteer’s **Wreath** indicates he is a more evolved form of the Fool. The Woman in Strength’s **Wreath** of Roses means

control of the desire nature. The **Wreath** on the head of the Child in card 19 represent the Zodiac and correspond to the belt of The Fool. The **Wreath** surrounding the figure in card 21 symbolizes nothing limits the Dancer except the Laws of Nature, and the Will of the Higher Self. – ps8,57,125,142,312,338

**Y**

**YELLOW** - In the Tarot **Yellow** is the Color of the Mind and the color of the Self-Conscious represented by the Magician. The Animals in the Wheel of Fortune are all **Yellow**—the Action of Mind, indicating the Mind receiving instruction from the Spirit. **Yellow** is the color of the Sun and Solar Enlightenment.

**LIGHT YELLOW**- indicates the Mind of the Higher Self.

**DEEP YELLOW** - indicates the Mind of the lower self, the Self-Conscious and that of the Subconscious.

**YELLOW AND GREEN STRAND** - Detail in card 12 the Hanged Man symbolizing the Mind, the image-making faculty; and the Intellectual Subconscious, the image-executing faculty. – p201

**YELLOW CROWN** - Detail in card 4 the Emperor typifying the 10 emanations of the Life Power over which Reason and his wife Creative Imagination has control, and which his son, the Christ-Consciousness, can manipulate. – p73

**YELLOW RAYS** - Detail in card 19 the Sun. 21 **Yellow Rays**, 11 Straight and 10 Wavy Ones proceed from the Sun. They stand for the 21 numbered cards of the Tarot trumps. – p310

**YELLOW SPHERE** - Detail in card 4 the Emperor signifying the Christ-Consciousness, which represents the son of Reason. – p73

**YELLOW STAR** - Detail in card 17 the Star that means the combination of the Pineal and Pituitary in what is called The Mystic Marriage. – ps275,277

**YELLOW-GREEN** - In the Tarot **Yellow-Green** is the Color of the Spirit, which is represented by card 9 The Hermit.– p149

**YOD HEH VAV HEH** – Full version of the Hebrew name for Yahweh or Jehovah, The Creator usually written IHVH. Yod Heh Vav Heh in Greek is Tetragrammaton. – ps79,124

**YOD HEH WAW HEH** - Yod HeH Vav Heh intoned is spelled **Yod Heh Waw Heh**. – p79

**YOD spelled in Hebrew IVD** - Means Hand and is Number 10 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 6th Simple Letter. **Yod** stands for the Spirit, or Will and

represents the sun-sign Virgo ruled by Chiron and card 9 the Hermit. **Yod** is the conventionalized picture of a Flame of Fire and the base of every other letter, **Yod** is the most important letter in the Sacred Alphabet. – ps70,79, 117,149,150,152-154,158,197, 198,269,270,303,321

**Yoga** –In The Tarot the literal meanings of the Hindu word **Yoga** is “union with the Higher Self.” **Yoga** is a system of practice where an individual may make over his or her body and gain intuitive perception of the eternal principles of the Universe. – ps19,60,80,81,125,157,175,226,312,319

**Yoke** - Detail in card 5 the Hierophant and card 10 the Wheel of Fortune. In The Hierophant the **Yokes** of Yellow show they are like monks, entirely abandoned and dedicated to the Higher Self, the source of all Intuitions. In The Wheel of Fortune the halo of letters around the head of the Bull spells “The **Yoke** of The Law.” The Bull symbolizes the Law of Limitation. – ps87,89,175

## Z

**ZAIN spelled in Hebrew ZIN** - Means Sword and is Number 7 in the Hebrew Alphabet and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Simple Letter assigned to card 6 the Lovers.

Microcosmically, the sword in **Zain** stands for Discrimination to cut apart the Subconscious from the Self-Conscious. Cosmically or Macrocosmically speaking, it cuts apart the Will from the Substance. – ps97,99,105,271,304,305,321

**Zodiac** –The **Zodiac** is a teaching device invented by occult teachers to describe to Man how the Laws of the Universe (Macrocosm) work out in his own body. The ancients knew of the interrelation of all the parts of Man’s organism, or the Microcosm. What was outside was duplicated inside. What was Above was duplicated Below. – ps56,58,67,68,70,73,90,99,100, 155,186,217,218,223,224,299,305,312
